SAFETY MEASURES IN HONKY TONK CONTESTS AND LINEDANCE EVENTS

- The temperature will be measured upon entering
- All attendees must be registered in an entry register with name, address and telephone number, in case they must be located.
- All attendees will wear hygienic masks
- There will be no change of costumes between dances
- As in the Honky Tonk Contest, in the Line dance competition, the dancers will not leave the floor between dances, and will dance all three dances in a row.
- Wearing gloves is optional for contestants and the prohibition on this in the regulations is temporarily removed.
- Hydroalcoholic gel will be available to participants, and soap for hands in the toilets
- The minimum distance between contestants on the dance floor will be 1.5 m. being 2,00m recommended
- The capacity in the premises is limited in total to 50%
- The duration of the music will be limited to 1.15 minutes
- Two “waiting areas” are established for contestants before entering the dance floor. Both will be separated from the public, and the contestants will line up and respect the minimum distance between them
- The “Floor Coordinators” will wear a mask, gloves and a protective screen to organize the “waiting areas”
- The public and the contestants who have already danced, or who do not yet have to go to the waiting areas, will be seated, in pre-assigned seats.
- In the case of dancing on stage, the number of participants in each “heat” is limited to what corresponds, keeping the minimum distance between people.
- The hand microphones will have a protector, each “MC and DeeJay” will have its own protector. In the case of wireless microphones, each “MC and DeeJay” will have its own foam cover for the microphone.
- The "MC and DeeJays" will have Hydroalcoholic gel on the DeeJays' table to be used on their hands before and after their session. Likewise, there will be disinfectant liquid and wipes to clean computers and sound equipment.
